SERVICES ON ROUTE

1. TIMING STATION

Timing clocks will be placed at the start and finish points.

2. WATER, MEDICAL AND TOILET STATIONS

Water, Medical and Toilet Stations will be combined and located:

- At the start & finish point

All station will be clearly marked by signs placed at the station and 200m before the station.

3. WATER

Water will be supplied and take water whenever participants get the chance.

4. FIRST AID

First Aid Stations will be manned by Doctors/ Nurses.

5. AMBULANCE

Ambulance will be strategically positioned on the route.
